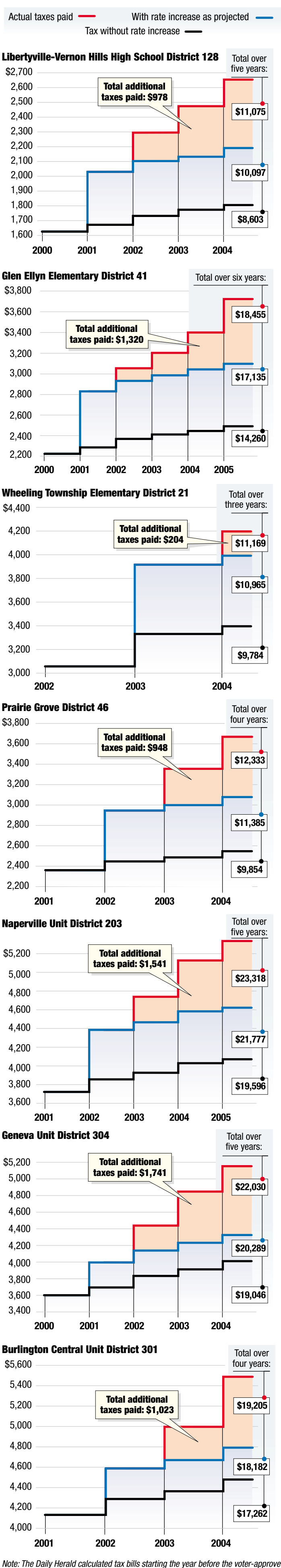


# The true cost of a school tax vote

Here are three scenarios showing what the owner of a \$300,000 house would have paid in property taxes to a school district.



Note: The Daily Herald calculated tax bills starting the year before the voter-approved tax increase took effect, using data obtained from county property tax records. The home was worth \$300,000 the first year, and in our calculation, increased in value at the average rate of growth in the district.
